District supports renovating warehouses in Livorno

LIVORNO, Italy – Nowhere else in the U.S. European Command does the term Power Projection mean more than at the Leghorn Army Depot in Livorno, Italy.

As the U.S. Army's only location in Europe with prepositioned stocks of heavy equipment and material, not to mention the largest ammunition storage area within U.S. Army, Europe Leghorn Army Depot is literally overrun with rows of warehouses and maintenance shops.

Yet the World War II-era warehouses that store the Army's high-tech equipment have only received a minor facelift in 60 years, leaving most of

them unventilated, without climate and humidity controls, and without the proper mechanical lift/storage and distribution systems.
