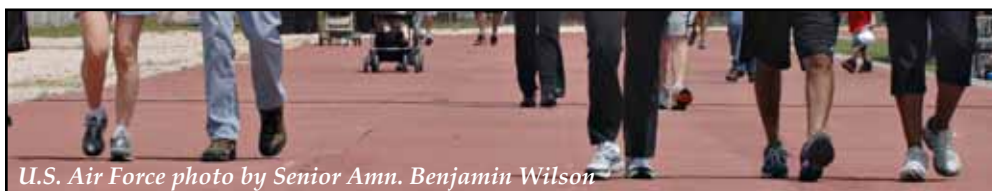
USACE People: On the track to success
