Europe District sees major projects, unique challenges in new countries in FY10

WIESBADEN, Germany – At 6 a.m. local time, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Europe District closed the books on fiscal year 2010 – only to pave the way for an anticipated record-breaking fiscal year with \$922 million predicted for FY2011.

Altogether, the district executed more than 1,700 actions totaling roughly \$768 million in FY2010 displaying its full-

spectrum engineer force of high-quality civilians and Soliders who spend each day providing vital engineering services and capabilities across the full spectrum of operations in support of national interests.

But the Europe District's real story lies in the milestones reached and new territory explored over the past year.
