MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: Site Safety and Health Officer (SSHO) Training Equivalencies.

- 1. PURPOSE: This memorandum provides U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) Europe District (NAU) guidance for identifying and accepting equivalent training for project SSHOs, in accordance with EM 385-1-1, chapter 2-3.b.
- 2. References.
 - a. EM385-1-1, USACE Safety and Health Requirements Manual.
 - b. OSHA Outreach Training Program
- 3. Background. EM 385-1-1 requires that individuals designated as SSHOs possess, at a minimum, OSHA 30-hour construction safety training or equivalent. The NAU Safety and Occupational Health Office (SOHO) is responsible for evaluating any training submitted for equivalency under EM 385-1-1, chapter 2-3.
- 4. In addition to formal OSHA 30-hour training, the SOHO has evaluated and determined that the following online courses meet the minimum training requirements for designation as an SSHO on NAU projects:
 - a. Advanced Online Solutions, OSHA 30-Hour Construction Training
 - Note: Note: Students providing an international address will receive a training certificate for "30-Hour Construction Safety Training" only.
 - b. Summit Training Source (HSI), OSHA 30-Hour Construction Training
 - Note: Course completion certificate will be proved for international students (No Card)
 - c. OSHA Education Center; 30-Hour International OSHA Training Online
- 5. The SOHO has evaluated the following Host Nation (HN) training certifications and determined that they meet the minimum training requirements for designation as an SSHO on NAU projects:
 - a. Germany:
 - 1) RAB30
 - b. Belgium
 - 1) Health & Safety Advisor level 2 (Advise in prevention level 2 CP2)
 - 2) Health & Safety Advisor level 1 (Advise in prevention level 1 CP2)
 - 3) Safety Coordinator Level B (Coordinator Safety-Health on Sites Temporary/Mobiles Level B)
 - 4) Safety Coordinator Level A (Coordinator Safety-Health on Sites Temporary/Mobiles Level A)
 - c. Romania
 - 1) Medium Level Certification for Safety Inspector (80 hours)
 - 2) Superior Level Certification for Safety Inspector (180 hours)
 - 3) Superior Level for Health & Safety Coordinator (IAW Romanian law) (90 hours)

- 6. The NAU SOHO encourages contractors to submit additional training programs to the NAU SOHO, through their Contracting Officer Representative (COR), for equivalency evaluation. All submissions must include, at a minimum, a side-by-side comparison to the OSHA 30-hour course content and requirements. This comparison should include the course name, required contact hours per topic, and the curriculum of subjects taught for each course.
